By signing this application, the holder of any license issued to the applicant agrees to waive all formalities regarding search and seizure during the duration of the license. Furthermore, the holder of the license agrees to waive the same formalities if the license is revoked or if the holder is ordered by a court of competent Jurisdiction to remove all alcohol, for as long as the holder owns or rents the previously licensed premises.

Each applicant for a Class R (restaurant) permit shall meet the following criteria:

1. Must operate a place of business whose purpose is primarily to prepare for consumption and to serve meals and meal items to the general public on all days of operation; have a fully equipped kitchen facility and dining room manned and operated at all times that alcoholic beverages are sold on Sunday. Must gross 50% of their monthly revenue from the sale of food, food items and non-alcoholic beverages. Food sales on premises and pickup/delivery/catered sales are to be maintained separately and maintain separate sales figures for alcoholic beverages.
2. Must furnish an affidavit from the local health department showing compliance with all applicable health and sanitary requirements with new applications.

New businesses without prior business experience on which to base a determination of percentage of food sales vs. alcoholic beverage sales, a temporary permit may be issued by the Board for 60 days, after which time evidence of all sales, as may be deemed necessary by the Board, will be required to make the permit permanent.

*The Class R permit shall be subject to revocation by the ABC Board at any time following a hearing (as provided for all other licenses and/or permits issued under the Wine, Beer and Liquor Ordinance) and a determination that the permit holder fails to meet the criteria set forth in the ordinance.*
